

Application Guidelines

Please read through the accompanying documents and check the following:

1. Applicants must be currently studying Year 12 Accounting
2. Applicants must have a minimum HA1 in Accounting certified by their teacher (to be checked at interview stage)
3. Discuss the application with your Accounting teacher who may be able to offer assistance and mentoring
4. Complete your application on Pages 2 and 3 by typing all the required information as follows:
 - ▶ your personal information and contact details
 - ▶ current, updated levels of achievement in **ALL** your subjects at Senior level
 - ▶ name and email contact of your Accounting teacher
 - ▶ preferences and plans for university education
 - ▶ career plans and ambitions
 - ▶ statement
 - ▶ special considerations (if applicable)

You **must** include a brief Resume (maximum of two pages) with additional information not already included in your application.

Do not forget the payment arrangements. Sometimes schools will pay for students, but you may need to cover the entry fee yourself. Check with your Accounting teacher as to the arrangements in place at your school.

Applications received will be distributed to the interview panellists prior to the date of interview. In addition, panellists will make use of these applications during the interview process. Applications must conform to a business standard. Please aim for top-quality presentation and ensure that you proofread and edit your application prior to submission.

Keith Goodwin Memorial Scholarships In Accounting & Business

Conditions of Entry

1. The Keith Goodwin Memorial Scholarships will be open to applicants among Grade 12 students who:
 - 1.1 are enrolled in a Grade 12 Accounting class in a Senior Secondary School in the region called “Cardwell to the Cape”.
 - 1.2 have demonstrated a **high** or **very high** level of achievement in Senior Accounting and an interest in business and commerce generally.
 - 1.3 **intend to enrol for a university course which includes the commerce/business disciplines - Accountancy, Business Studies or Economics amongst the subjects at first-year level;**
 - 1.4 intend to pursue a career in business and/or business teaching after graduation;
 - 1.5 in the opinion of the Scholarship Committee, deserve special consideration to support demonstrated potential in the pursuit of a commerce career, where tertiary studies may be adversely affected by personal and/or financial hardship. (This only applies to winner of Award, and not all other categories).
2. Interviews of potential new applicants will be mandatory and will take place in Term 4 of the applicant’s Grade 12 year.
 - 2.1 The decision of the Scholarship Committee regarding the final recipient will not be made until the potential recipient has presented proof of acceptance into a business and/or commerce discipline (refer 1.3).
 - 2.2 Should a recipient defer, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withdraw and/or re-award the Scholarship.
 - 2.3 The Scholarship will be awarded during Semester I of the first year of tertiary study.
3. Each Scholarship awarded will provide assistance towards study and living expenses and the value of the Scholarship will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. The scholarship may be held concurrently with other awards.
4. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to consider special applications which may be submitted to it in the future.

Senior Secondary Departments offering Senior Accounting in the area implied by the term “Cardwell to the Cape” in 1.1.

This list is updated annually in consultation with the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority, so that all eligible students have an opportunity to apply. Not all schools in the region offer Year 12 Accounting every year.
