Please read the attached details and conditions carefully and forward completed application form/s by Monday 2nd September. All entries must be forwarded to St Andrew's Catholic College by 4th October.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Students currently in grade 11 or 12 and studying an Applied Technologies subject.
2. Students must achieve an (A) or (B) from school-based assessment.
3. Students are required to create a portfolio of technical drawings demonstrating drafting processes. The folio of drawings can be from any of the drafting contexts listed below:
 - Residential building
 - Construction
 - CAD
 - Engineering
 - Building and construction
 - Furnishing
4. Students must be available for a judging interview if required.
5. Students must be available for the presentation night if selected.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. The application form which has been completed by the nominating student.
2. Client portfolio must include the following items:
 - A copy of the school's assessment task sheet issued to student. This is to provide the judges with a clear understanding of the industry context, audience and the purpose of the drawings.
 - Students are to compile a portfolio of their technical CAD drawings that demonstrate knowledge, understanding and skills in industry practices and drafting processes.
 - Students are required to submit documentation (up to 8 pages) to show their planning and evaluation processes. This can be a multi-modal or written component.
 - Students may submit any physical 3D prototype models that were created during their drafting processes.
3. Application forms must be signed by a Head of Department and the School Principal in order to verify the student information is correct.
4. The student must submit one A4 typed page discussing their future career plans.
5. The recipients of the awards will then be notified, and the awards will be presented on Thursday, 28th November at a presentation function to be held at the Pullman Cairns International Hotel, Cairns at 4:45pm – 7:30 pm.

The decision of the judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

PRIZES / BURSARY

Winner

The winner of the award will receive \$1000.00 plus a personalised certificate.

Runner Up

The runner up will receive a personalised certificate, which is supported by a \$600 bursary.

Encouragement Award

The student who receives an encouragement award will be given a personalised certificate, which is supported by a \$400 bursary.

APPLICATON FEES

An application fee of \$88 (GST inc), which will cover administration costs. Only one fee per school irrelevant of the number of entries sent. Schools will be invoiced following receipt of application.
