The award is open to all Senior (Year 12) students in the Far North Region. The Awards are in the form of a personalised Certificate, which is supported by a \$1000 Bursary for the Winner. There will be bursaries for the Runner-up (\$700) and Encouragement Awards (\$300).

Please read the attached details and conditions carefully and forward completed application form/s by **Monday, 2 September 2024**. Entries are to be submitted to St Andrew's Catholic College by **Friday, 4 October 2024**.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Students currently in grade 12 and participating in ATAR Engineering.
2. Students must achieve an A or B from a school-based assessment.
3. Students must develop a physical and/or virtual prototype that provides an engineered solution to a civil structural problem. They must also create a summary report that communicates their problem-solving process to the client and submit an engineered solution.
4. Students must be available for a judging interview if required.
5. Students must be available for the presentation night if selected.

## APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. The application form which has been completed by the nominating student.
2. Client portfolio must include the following items:
  - Part A: create a folio to document a solution to an engineering problem, which meets the requirements of a specified client.
  - Part B - provide the specified client with a summary report of the preferred solution to the engineering problem.
3. The student must submit one A4 typed page discussing their future career plans.
4. Application forms must be signed by a Head of Department and the School Principal in order to verify the student information is correct.
5. The recipients of the awards will then be notified, and the awards will be presented on Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> November at a presentation function to be held at the Pullman Cairns International Hotel, Cairns at 4:45pm – 7.30 pm.

## PRIZE / BURSARY

### Winner

The winner of the award will receive \$1000.00 and a certificate.

### Runner Up

The runner up will receive a certificate, which is supported by a \$700 bursary.

### Encouragement Award

The students who receives an encouragement award will be given a certificate, which is supported by a \$300 bursary.
