APPLICATION GUIDELINES

This year there is one \$1,000.00 prize for First Place, one \$700 prize for the Runner-up Award and a \$300.00 Encouragement Award to be given to assist school leavers pursue tertiary studies in the fields of Health and Physical Education. Please note the allocation may vary from year to year depending on applications received.

These Awards are sponsored by:

- Calanna Whole Health Pharmacy, Mareeba Leagues Club and Peninsula Sporting Goods, in conjunction with the Business Liaison Association Inc.

A representative from the Sponsors will present the Awards at a ceremony to be held in Cairns on the **28th November 2019**.

The application process has been streamlined from previous years. The candidate nominated by each school will be interviewed. Interviews will be held on the 17th October 2019.

The steps attached are to be followed to be eligible for an interview.

A panel consisting of Sponsors, Department of Education Qld staff and Peninsula School Sport representative will decide final winners.

CRITERIA

1. Students must have a VHA or HA for Health and Physical Education. The students Semester One profile must be submitted. Only one student from each school can be nominated for interview. It is up to the school to determine their top student.
2. Students must demonstrate evidence of relevant Tertiary Studies in the field of Physical Education or Health via verification by Principal and Head of Department Signatures on the Nomination Form. Attaching a copy of students' QTAC Form is desirable.
3. Please note – this award has been altered to represent the subject of Physical Education and not the students sporting achievements or involvement. The sporting section on the nomination form is for the sole purpose of the interview panel having some background on each candidate.
4. The interview process will be the sole determinant in the selection of award winners. At interview, students will be asked specific questions regarding
 - Future tertiary aspirations
 - Personal values
 - What they have learnt through their study of Physical Education and how they have applied their knowledge in their sporting careers



APPLICATION CONTENT

Applications should be processed through the Health and Physical Education Department at the School and must include the components below. Applications are due on **16th September 2019**.

1. The Nomination Form is to be completed by the student and verified by the Principal and the Head of Department.
2. A copy of the QTAC Form to verify Tertiary preferences – where possible.
3. A copy of the student's Semester one profile – including the rung placement allocated
