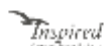

Award recipients are required to attend the Presentation Evening and are to wear Formal School Uniform.

PORTFOLIO GUIDELINES

It is preferable that the portfolio is submitted as a PowerPoint or PDF file and should contain:

- Cover page – Students Name and School
- A short artist's statement (max 300 words) which shows the panel
 - why and how you make your art (Your art practice)
 - what art means to you (Your art passions)
 - your aspirations in a future Arts career (Your direction)
- 10 - 15 pages / slides highlighting specific examples of your artwork and practice
 - Pages should show individual resolved work which includes artwork title, date, medium and size.
 - Consider including images to show process of work and / or text to clearly distinguish your own concepts and ideas behind the work, creativity, and high levels of making and production skills.
 - Selected images should demonstrate artwork originality and creativity

APPLICATION CONTENTS

Applications should be processed through the Arts Department at the School and must include the components below.

- The Registration Form [application form] is to be completed by the student and **verified** by the Principal and the Head of Department. This form can be filled in online if you have the latest Adobe Acrobat reader.
Otherwise, just print and fill in neatly by hand.
- Submission of a **digital portfolio** which demonstrates high levels of making and production skills and an articulated interest and understanding of the value of Arts practice.
- **All registration application forms must be forwarded to Leanne Shead at lshead@stmonica.qld.edu.au by MONDAY 11 September 2023 by 5pm (Term 3, Week 10)**
- **All portfolios must be forwarded to Leanne Shead at lshead@stmonicas.qld.edu.au by MONDAY 9 October 2023 by 5pm (Term 4, Week 2)**
- **Announcements of finalists (withholding awards allocated) will be made via email on FRIDAY 20 October 2023 (Week 3, Term 4)**

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

The awards are sponsored by: Oxlades School Art Supplies, Art Work Spaces, PAEA, REACH, Department of Education, Artview Gallery and Inspired CCS Inc [The Kite Gallery].

- Art Work Spaces is providing a \$700 prize
- Oxlades is providing \$500, \$250 and \$200 prizes
- PAEA is providing a \$400 prize
- REACH is providing a \$300 prize
- The Department of Education is providing a \$250 Indigenous Encouragement Award for Indigenous students wishing to further their study in the Visual Arts at either Tertiary level or TAFE.
- Oxlades, Artview Gallery and Inspired CCS are providing \$200 each prizes to students who have not applied to pursue Tertiary Studies but demonstrate high achievement within their chosen discipline.

- A representative from the sponsors will present the awards at a ceremony on Thursday 23 November, 2023 at the Pullman Cairns International Hotel.

- Successful applicants are expected to be present at the ceremony to receive their award. Students will be expected to wear School Formal Uniform as directed by their respective schools.

A panel of three members, an Oxlades representative and two local Art Industry representatives from the sponsors will meet to shortlist and decide on the awarding of the nine prizes.

The judges' decisions will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

CRITERIA

- Submission of a digital portfolio which demonstrates their achievement in one or more of the Visual Arts areas.
- Demonstrated evidence of intent to pursue Tertiary Studies (either at University or TAFE) in the field of Visual Arts which has been verified by the Principal and Head of Department.
- Achievement of a B standard (65% ATAR expectation), or above, in one or more Visual Arts subjects (which may be QCE Visual Art, General/Applied or TAFE subjects)
- Participation by student in a school, regional or state exhibition program. Eg: Receive<Respond, ENERGY.
- Demonstrated high levels of making and production skills and an articulated interest and understanding of the value of Arts practice.

PRIZE / BURSARY

The Business Liaison Association Inc, in conjunction with Oxlades and the Peninsula Art Educators' Association, is offering bursaries for students of the Cairns Region interested in pursuing a career in the Visual Arts or Creative Industries through study at Tertiary or TAFE Level. The Bursaries will be open to Year 12 students studying Visual Arts (General or Applied), Photography, Film and Television.
