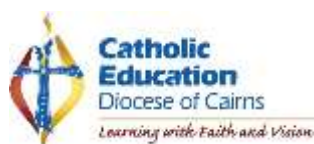

## MEDICAL SCIENCES AWARDS

This exciting new Award for 2023 in the Medical Sciences field was developed to encourage young people to pursue tertiary studies in Medicine at James Cook University. It is anticipated that when they are qualified, they will seek to serve in rural and remote communities where there is an extreme shortage of medical staff.

Rotary Club of Cairns Sunrise, Brien Leibinger Lawyers, Right at Home and Catholic Education Diocese of Cairns are sponsors of these awards in conjunction with the Business Liaison Association to assist the student/s with tertiary educational expenses. The recipient of these awards will receive \$1000 each. This will be paid upon their successful enrolment and acceptance in a Bachelor of Medicine at James Cook University with evidence produced to secure this funding.

A representative of the sponsors will present these awards at a special ceremony to be held at the Pullman Cairns International Hotel 23 November 2023 from 5.30pm to 7.30pm. All students receiving awards must be in attendance on this evening in formal school uniform.

## CRITERIA

1. Students must have completed units 3 and 4 with an A in the prerequisite subjects of English, Mathematical Methods and Chemistry. These results would be based on the predicted Level of Achievement at the end of Year 12.
2. Predicted ATAR score greater than 89.75 verified by school Principal.
3. Students have to study Medicine at James Cook University – Cairns/Townsville. The student must have indicated this on the QTAC form as their first preference and verified by the school Principal.
4. To accept the scholarship and receive the bursary the student must be accepted into James Cook University Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery to begin in 2024.
5. Students must submit a typed short essay (up to 500 words typed) on why they want to be a medical practitioner in rural or remote communities.

Application forms should be processed through the Science Department of the school.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

**Academic reports should be photocopied and be sent with the Application Form**

**Applications should contain two copies of the following:**

- 1 a) The completed application form which includes an attachment outlining student interests and achievements.  
**THE NOMINATING STUDENT MUST COMPLETE THE APPLICATION.**
  - b) Photocopied academic report card (**please DO NOT send originals**).
  - c) short essay (500 words typed) on why they want to be a medical practitioner in rural or remote communities.
  - d) Application forms must be signed by a Head of Department and the Principal in order to verify the student information is correct.
2. From the application forms received, a number of students will be selected for an interview by a chosen panel. This panel will consist of a sponsor representative, and James Cook University Alumni Medical Practitioners. Students who are successful in gaining an interview will be notified by Friday, 6 October and an interview time arranged for Thursday, 12 October 2023
3. The recipient of the award will then be notified, and the award will be presented on Thursday, 23 November at a presentation function to be held at the Pullman Cairns International Hotel, Cairns at 5.30 – 7.30 pm.
